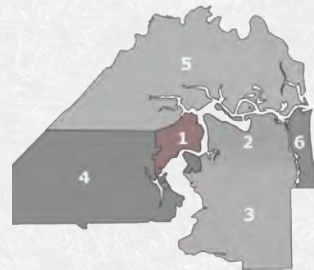

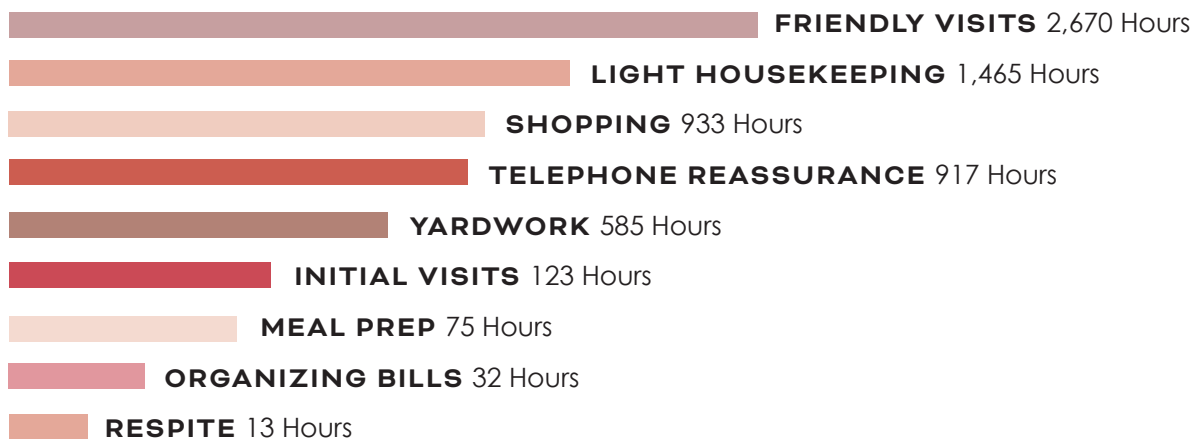

Ms. Linda's hot water heater hasn't worked in a while. She's been heating water on the stove and carrying it into the bathroom to bathe. Snyder replaced her hot water heater and she said, "Oh thank you so much. Thank you, Jesus, now I'll have hot water! May God shower blessings upon you."

Ms. Agnes needed to move due to a major mold issue. We helped her with a deposit for a new place to live. When we told her we paid it, she said, "Thank you so much! I truly appreciate it ... Thank you again."

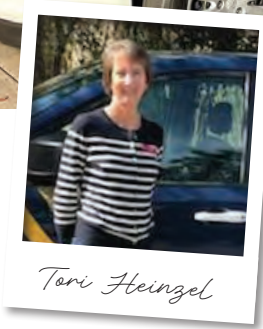

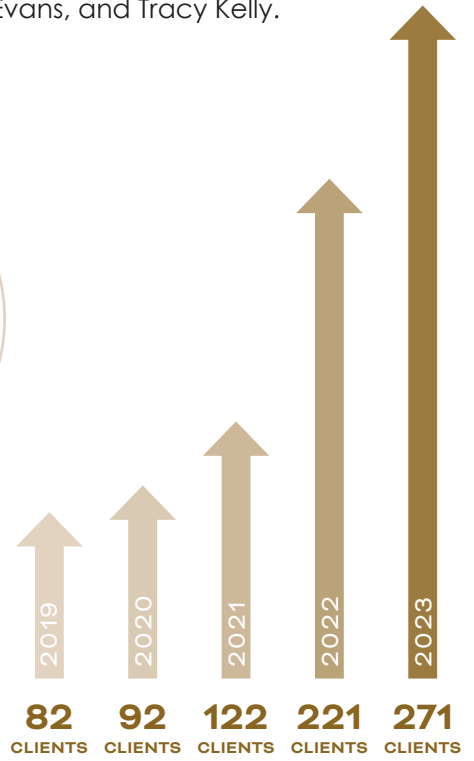

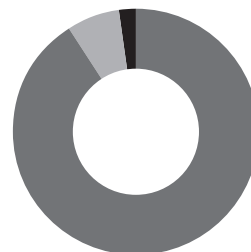
